UNIT 1 - Review Timeline

1914 - World War I starts

1917 - March - Russian Revolution - provisional government

1917 - April - USA enters World War I

1917 - November - 2nd Russian Revolution - Bolsheviks take over

1918 - Jan. Wilson publishes 14 Points
- Jan. Lenin dismisses Constituent Assembly

1918 - March - Treaty of Brest-Litovsk - ends war between Germany & Russia

1918 - spring - Russian civil war starts - between Reds and Whites

1918 - November - Armistice, fighting stops World War I

1919 - Jan. - attempted communist uprising in Germany (Spartikists) crushed
- Paris Peace talks begin
- allied blockade of Germany continues

1919 - June - Germany signs Treaty of Versailles, other defeated nations sign
other Paris Peace Treaties

1920 - new state of Poland attacks Russia

1921 - end of Russian civil war, Reds win

1921 - bill set for German reparations 6.6 billion pounds

1921 - Kronstadt mutiny in Russia

1921 - Lenin starts New Economic Policy, as a result of mutiny

1921 - Treaty of Riga, ends Russo-Polish war, Poles get some Russian territory

1924 - Jan. - Lenin dies. Rivalry between Trotsky and Stalin for leadership of USSR
